## Land Development Regulations, Sec. 8.01.07

### **Political Signs**

All political signs shall be subject to the following limitations:

- A. Political signs shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet of surface area per side.
- B. Permits and fees are not required for political signs.
- C. *Time limit.* No political sign may be erected earlier than
  - (1) Twenty (20) days prior to the election to which the political sign pertains; or
  - (2) At such time as an opponent in the general election shall be permitted to erect such a sign; that is, an unopposed candidate for nomination in a primary may erect signs, in those instances in which there are two (2) or more candidates for nomination in the primary of an opposing party, twenty (20) days prior to each primary.
- D. *Location.* No political sign shall be placed on or over any public property or public or private road right-of-way. No political sign shall be placed on private property without the consent of the owner of such property who shall be responsible for any violations and the ultimate removal of the sign (s).
- E. *Removal.* Each political sign shall be removed by the property owner within ten (10) days after the election, except that a winning candidate in a primary election may continue to maintain his political signs until ten (10) days after the general election.
